

Anger Group

The Anger Group is a six-week course in which we look at what it is that may contribute to and underlie presenting anger, how anger may present and coping strategies / techniques to work with this.

The best indicator of success is motivation to engage and people report a greater understanding of what is happening for them by the end of the course.

GROUP AIMS:

- 1. To provide a forum to gain understanding of the causes of anger and to learn new skills for preventing the onset of anger and aggression.
- 2. To explore practical, do-able things that will add to each individual's resources/toolkit for managing anger.
- 3. To provide support and encouragement in a confidential and safe atmosphere.
- 4. To enable use of learnt skills and techniques beyond completion of the programme.

WHO IS THE GROUP FOR?

The Anger Group is accessed by self-referral only. Clients will have identified as having difficulties in controlling anger, who recognise this as an issue and who are motivated and committed to learn new skills.
